Only one site was questionable and that site will be followed up by the Progressive Engineering Company. The testing was done on Monday July 3rd, after the long 4th of July weekend thinking that septic tanks might indeed be stressed at this time.

Visitors, Don Winne, president of Michigan Lakes and Streams Association and Pearl Bonnell, treasurer were introduced.

Don spoke to the group about his involvement with the HLA. He became aware of our oil problems in 1983. Also an article about Hamlin Lake was featured in The Riparian Magazine and a picture on the lake was on the cover. Mr. Winne is the editor of the magazine.
